

Covid-19 - Risk Assessment

Date of Assessment: March 2022

- * KS1 and KS2 groups will distance to avoid congestion in the foyer.
- * Parents will continue to collect children from outside the building. If parents needs to speak to a member of staff they can enter through to the office.
- * The daily check will be Covid-19 aware.
- * Public Health posters / hand washing posters are displayed around the Club.

SESSION

- * On entering the building in key stage groups, KS1 will enter first and wash hands in the toilet area. KS2 will wash hands at the end of the main room.
- * During the session stringent hygiene routines will be adhered to both child's personal care.
- * Children will be supported in understanding the part they need to play in keeping themselves safe and healthy.
- * Staff will be aware that children's mental health and the importance of supporting them.
- * Windows will be open in the building at all times to provide ventilation.
- * Parents are asked to keep their child at home if they have a temperature and/or suspect they may have Covid-19.
- * Staff will check a child's temperature if they have any concerns.

STAFF

- * All staff need to adhere to our Covid-19 Policy/Procedure and Risk Assessment.
- * If they staff have any reason to suspect they have Covid-19 they should not come into work.

PPF

Other PPE is as normal, gloves and aprons.

CLEANING

- * Regularly used areas and equipment will be cleaned throughout the session.
- * Disposable gloves need to be worn for cleaning and disposed of as necessary
- Wash hands after removing gloves.
- Where possible disposable cloths to be used for cleaning.

COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS

- As physical communication with parents will be limited key People/Staff and parents may need to communicate via email.
- * Parents will be emailed any updates regarding Covid-19.



EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

- * If a child becomes ill with Covid-19 symptoms, they will be sent home to isolate following Covid-19 guidelines.
- * If clinical advice is needed settling staff or parent should go online to NHS111 or cal 111.
